What is the project's organized goal with a foreseeable, long-term benefit? Does the project benefit a significant number of people in the community with positive measurable results? How would a grant from HCCF be recognized?
- **B.** Applicant Organization A brief description of the history of the applicant organization, when it was founded, and who it serves.
- **C. Project Team -** List the names and responsibilities of persons involved in planning and implementing the project. List any organizations that will assist you.
- **D. Evaluation** Describe how you will determine if you accomplished your purpose.
- E. **Budget –** Include estimated project income and expenses. Include names of other incomes sources and whether these funds have been secured, as well as any fundraising.
